- Rising junior or senior in good standing
- Currently has an internship in New York City in fashion OR business for pay or academic credit
- Maintains at least a 3.0 GPA, preferably in a business-related major (though other majors are welcome to apply)
- Able to attend all events (evenings on 7/22, 7/23 and 7/24)

Program Notes

For Undergraduates, we recommend **Track 1**, which involves back to back Career Path Workshops.

More advanced students who have considerable business experience can request **Track 2**, which involves one Career Path Workshop, followed by a hands-on Business Case Study Workshop.

Career Path Workshops give participants the opportunity to interact with industry professionals and human resources (HR) managers. Participants will learn about specific jobs and companies and gain insight into what HR managers seek in job candidates.

The **Business Case Study Workshop** is a real world business plan case study intended to give participants a chance to put their existing business skills to work, gaining industry specific knowledge and the chance to work closely with fashion business professionals.
